

GUIDE TO RESTARTING YOUR EQUIPMENT



Ice Machines All Sotto, Neo, Indigo & NXT machines

Safely restarting your equipment after a shutdown.









Following a long period of your Manitowoc Ice machine being in a state of non-use, it is possible that the unit may attract moisture & bacteria. This document outlines the steps to be followed in ensuring your ice machine safe for use.

If you were unable to completely decommission your ice machine before closure, it is necessary to carry out a full clean of the machine and its components prior to use following the steps outlined below.

- 1. Check all power cables for any signs of damage If any damage is noted, do not use the unit until a qualified engineer has repaired.
- 2. Reconnect the ice machine to your water supply & drain connections. Be sure to check none of the pipework is kinked or blocked.
- 3. If you have a water filter installed (recommended for all installations) ensure there is sufficient life remaining in the cartridge. Manitowoc cartridges have a maximum shelf life of 6 months from installation. This may be lower in hard water areas. Replace if necessary.
- 4. Carry out a full sanitise of the ice machine in line with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Ensure you only use approved Manitowoc Ice Machine Cleaner & Sanitiser.
- 6. Your ice machine is now ready for normal use. Please allow a minimum of 3 batches of ice to be made before use.
